The United African University of Tanzania (UAUT) invites Applications from qualified candidates for admission to the Undergraduate degree Programs for the academic year 2020/2021. Form six and diploma graduates with required performances detailed under each program are encouraged to apply.

- ❖ **The 2<sup>nd</sup> Window on 09<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2020.**

## A. SPECIFIC ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR DEGREE PROGRAMMES

### PROGRAMMES OFFERED AT UAUT, KIGAMBONI DAR ES SALAAM

#### (a) **BSc. in Computer Engineering and Information Technology**

Program Duration: 4 years

Admission Capacity: 100

Tuition fee: Tshs 1,500,000 per year

#### **Minimum Entrance Requirements**

- (i) **Direct Entry (Form VI):** Two principal passes in Advanced Mathematics and Physics.
- (ii) **Equivalent Qualifications:** Diploma in Computer Science, Computer Engineering, Computer Engineering and Information Technology, Electrical Engineering, Electronics Engineering, Information Technology, Mechanical Engineering, Telecommunication Engineering or Computer and Information Communication Technology with an average of "B" or a minimum GPA of 3.0

#### (b) **Bachelor of Business Administration** (Accounting, Marketing & HRM)

Program Duration: 3 years

Admission Capacity: 100

Tuition fee: Tshs 1,200,000 per year

#### **Minimum Entrance Requirements**

- (i) **Direct Entry (Form VI):** Two principal passes in the following subjects: History, Geography, Kiswahili, English Language, French, Arabic, Fine Art, Economics, Commerce, Accountancy, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Advanced Mathematics, Agriculture, Computer

Science or Nutrition. If one of the principals is not Advanced Mathematics, an applicant must have a subsidiary pass in Advanced Mathematics /Basic Applied Mathematics at A-Level or a minimum of "D" grade in Mathematics at O-Level.

- (ii) Equivalent Qualifications:** Diploma in Accounting, Business Administration, Commerce, Procurement and Supplies Management, Marketing, Human Resources Management, Material Management, Economics, Entrepreneurship, Accounting and Finance, Procurement and Logistics Management, Business And Project Management, Marketing and Public Relations, Customs and Tax Administration, Economic Development, Public Sector Finance Management, Marketing, Insurance and Risk Management with an average of "B" or a minimum GPA of 3.0.

### **B. GENERAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAM (APPLICANT CATEGORY & MINIMUM ENTRY QUALIFICATIONS)**

#### **1. Completed A-Level before 2014**

Two principal passes with a total of 4.0 points from Two Subjects defining the admission into the respective program (where A = 5; B = 4; C = 3; D = 2; E = 1)

#### **2. Completed A- Level in 2014 and 2015**

Two principal passes (Two Cs) with a total of 4.0 points from Two Subjects defining the admission into the respective program (where A = 5; B+ =4; B = 3; C = 2; D =1)

#### **3. Completed A- Level from 2016**

Two principal passes with a total of 4.0 points from Two Subjects defining the admission into the respective program (where A = 5; B = 4; C = 3; D = 2; E = 1)

#### **4. Equivalent applicants**

At least four O' – Level passes (Ds and above) or NTA Level III with four O' – Level passes or equivalent foreign qualifications as established by the either NECTA or VETA; AND At least a GPA of 3.0 for Ordinary Diploma (NTA Level 6); OR Average of B for Full Technician Certificate (FTC) (where A = 5; B = 4; C = 3 and D = 2 points); OR Average of 'B+' Grade for Diploma in Teacher Education; OR Average of 'B+' Grade for Health related awards such as Clinical Medicine and others; OR A Distinction for unclassified diplomas and certificates Upper Second Class for classified non – NTA diploma
